Cabin Leader Information

- Camp exists for the sole purpose of encouraging kids to grow in Christ. Camp is kid oriented - not program, not adult, nor anything else. All that happens at camp is geared to meet the needs of children. Therefore, it is incumbent upon all leadership to realize their own needs and preferences are secondary to those of the campers. Cabin leaders are to be an example in attitude, actions, relationships, speech, dress, spirituality, sportsmanship and respect.
- Expect to deal peaceably with variant and sometimes conflicting personalities.
- You must obey all expressed and implied camp rules.
- You are responsible for everything that goes on within the walls of your assigned cabin.
- You should be aware of the whereabouts of your campers at all times as you will be with them at all times.
- You must attend all scheduled activities for their duration accompanied by your campers.
- You are expected to attend all cabin leader meetings. (See schedule)
- All behavioral problems and disputes are to be brought to the "Head Cabin Leader". Under no circumstances may a Cabin Leader hit a camper.
- All Cabin Leaders are required to (joyfully) participate in camp activities. Remember that kids are often experts in facial gestures, attitude & body language. Maintain a positive attitude inside and out.
- Model for your kids respect toward leadership and camp rules.
- All Cabin Leaders and campers are expected to attend every service, activity and meal. There are no exceptions. Bring sick or injured campers to the camp First Aid person.
- Cabin Leaders need to stick with their kids and not group together with other Cabin Leaders.
- Any relationship you are interested in pursuing with another adult leader needs to be pursued apart from camp.
- Report broken, damaged equipment or property immediately to the Head Cabin Leaders.
- Expect to be stretched in everyway. It is important to come to camp well rested.
- Vehicles must stay parked unless permission is otherwise given by Camp Director.
- Permission to leave camp must be obtained from the Camp Director. This should be only in case of an emergency, not for leisure.
- Remember that you represent Christ, your Pastor, your Church and yourself.

Camp Guidelines

- All are to conduct themselves as Christians in speech, attitude, and general behavior.
- **WHAT NOT TO BRING:** Electronic devices, radios, tape or CD players, weapons, flammables, explosives, drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes, matches, magazines or books.
- No one is to be outside their cabins before wake up or after lights out.
- Campers are not allowed in cabins other than their own. Guys are not permitted to enter the area of a girls cabins and vice versa.
- No food or drink is permitted in the sanctuary at any time.
- Destruction of any property (camp, campers, or church) is forbidden. All violators will be billed for damages.
- Make sure the clothes you bring are appropriate and modest. You will be required to change clothes that are deemed inappropriate. **No Spaghetti Straps, No Tight Blouses, No Revealing Shorts & No 2 Piece Bathing Suits. And under no circumstances will questionable advertisement on T-shirts be allowed!**
- **NO RAIDING!** Do not touch anyone else's stuff without their express permission to do so!
- Possession or use of tobacco, alcohol, narcotics, secular music, inappropriate literature, explosives, and/or weapons is prohibited.
- No cussing, fighting or stealing.
- You must attend all required activities for the duration. No unsupervised activities.
- This is not the Love Boat! Keep your hands to yourself.
- Obey all staff! Verbal or physical abuse of staff or campers will not be tolerated.
- Absolutely no sneaking out.
- Stay within camp boundaries.
- No leaving the campground without express permission from the Camp Director.
- Open your heart to God and let Him change your life! It's going to be an awesome Camp!
